





Tell the FTC: Essentials (Workers Oppose the Kroger Albertsons Merger!

How would the Kroger Albertsons megamerger hurt essential workers?

- LOWER WAGES: The Economic Policy Institute projected that the merger would lower wages for 746,000 essential grocery store workers in over 50 metropolitan areas across the U.S., or one in four of all grocery workers in the United States.
- HIGHER FOOD PRICES: Studies have shown that consumer prices have historical risen when grocery retailers merge in concentrated markets.
- **FEWER STORES:** When corporations merge, they often have to close or divest stores.

It's not too late. The FTC has the power to take action to block this megamerger and protect wages and jobs.
